

Cassette Girls "Old Mobile Fort Louis de la Lousiane 1702-*1711*" by Jay Higginbotham, describes their shipboard experiences and the travel to Mobile. These young women were quickly named the 'cassette' girls because the French government gave each volunteer some clothing and a small trunk called a 'cassette' to take with them to America. Some of the young ladies died of illness after arrival or fell ill aboard ship. The first consignment reached Mobile in 1704.


Payment to get rid of the girl Daughter is viewed as a liability

The main reason many girls become "leftover women" is that their standards for a partner are too high. The perfect man may exist, but why on earth would he want to marry you?


Tip #3: If you do bag a man, do keep up appearances



Genghis Khan (r. 1206-1227)



Father was a chieftain
Delivered to father of future bride at age 9
Father poisoned, Temuchin returned to claim position but young
Family abandoned to live in poverty. Captured/enslaved in a raid at age 15 but escaped.
Marries at 16, but she is kidnapped. Rescued. First son born 9 months later



Genghis Khan (r. 1206-1227)



Practiced meritocracy (except himself) Encouraged religious tolerance Prohibited Mongols from sedentary occupations Did not automatically kill conquered tribes

A coalition of tribes

Rescue of young bride

Based on plunder

Now need permission Share spoils with warriors





Expansion of European trade



Muslim Eunuch at age 10 Servant/advisor to future emperor




Seven Voyages of Zheng He


1405-33


